“After the commissioning, the technicians appointed by Tenderer will carry out the training of 6 (six) employees of Contracting Authority for the use of new technological solutions in regular production processes, specifically the use of PLC system built into the new drawing lines so that employees can use the acquired knowledge in managing and automating production systems and connecting machines that are part of the production process.

The duration of the training of employees is minimum 20 (twenty) business days.

Travel expenses, board and lodging costs arising during the effective performance of the commissioning and training are included in financial offer. Contracting Authority will organize transport of the technicians appointed by the Tenderer from the Hotel to Contracting Authority premises and back.

Any additional days and costs due to COVID-19 restrictions (e.g., mandatory quarantine or self-isolation) are not part of financial offer and will be determined additionally between Tenderer and Contracting Authority.”

Changes to:

“After the commissioning, the technicians appointed by Tenderer will carry out the training of 6 (six) employees of Contracting Authority for the use of new technological solutions in regular production processes, specifically the use of PLC system built into the new drawing lines so that employees can use the acquired knowledge in managing and automating production systems and connecting machines that are part of the production process.

The duration of the training of employees is minimum 20 (twenty) business days. **If possible, Tenderer is allowed to provide the training of employees during the commissioning.**
